

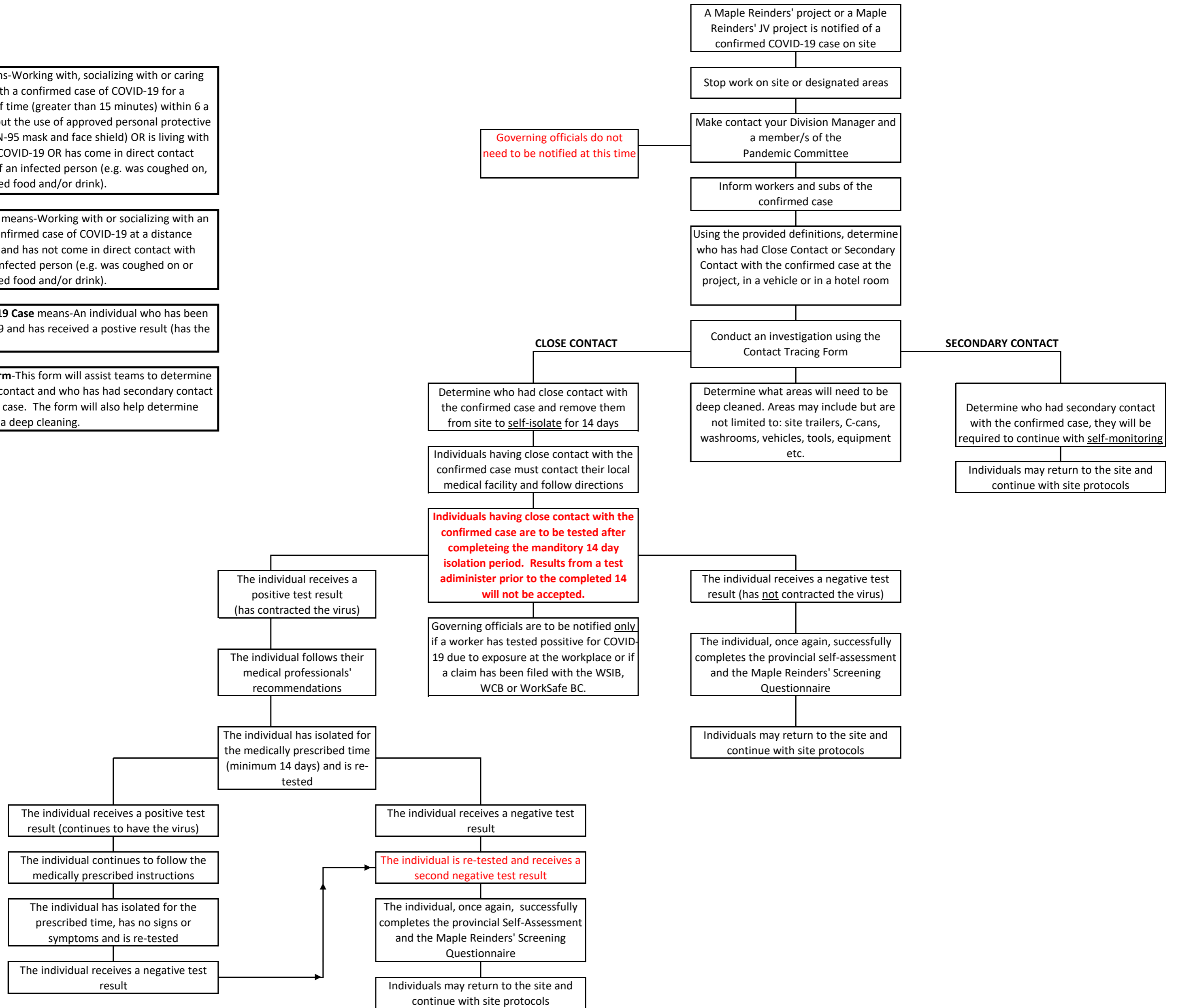
**Confirmed COVID-19 Case - Response Flowchart - Project Locations**

**Close Contact** means-Working with, socializing with or caring for an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19 for a prolonged period of time (greater than 15 minutes) within 6 a foot distance without the use of approved personal protective equipment (fitted N-95 mask and face shield) OR is living with someone who has COVID-19 OR has come in direct contact with bodily fluids of an infected person (e.g. was coughed on, sneezed on or shared food and/or drink).

**Secondary Contact** means-Working with or socializing with an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19 at a distance greater than 6 feet and has not come in direct contact with bodily fluids of an infected person (e.g. was coughed on or sneezed on or shared food and/or drink).

**Confirmed COVID-19 Case** means-An individual who has been tested for COVID-19 and has received a positive result (has the virus).

**Contact Tracing Form**-This form will assist teams to determine who has had close contact and who has had secondary contact with the confirmed case. The form will also help determine what areas require a deep cleaning.



Governing officials do not need to be notified at this time

Individuals having close contact with the confirmed case are to be tested after completing the mandatory 14 day isolation period. Results from a test administered prior to the completed 14 will not be accepted.

Governing officials are to be notified only if a worker has tested positive for COVID-19 due to exposure at the workplace or if a claim has been filed with the WSIB, WCB or WorkSafe BC.

The individual is re-tested and receives a second negative test result
